## Intensive Korean Language Program

- A structured 10-week Korean language program designed for study and academic purposes.
- Focus on practical communication skills in Korean, with culture classes integrated into the language curriculum

### 1. Target Students

Male and Female foreigners or overseas Koreans with at least a high school diploma

#### 2. Required Documents

### 1) For Non D-4 Visa Applicants

- ① Online Application via the website(http://atom.ewha.ac.kr)
- ② Copy of passport
- ③ Copy of Alien Registration Card (front & back; for visa holders only)
- ④ Copy of graduation certificate from the most recent school, AND certificate of enrollment if currently attending university

### 2) For D-4 Visa Applicants (from Visa Waiver Countries)

- ① Online Application via the website(http://atom.ewha.ac.kr)
- ② Copy of passport
- ③ Original graduation certificate from the most recent school(with Apostille) AND original certificate of enrollment(if currently attending university)
- ④ Original bank balance certificate under applicant's or a parent's name -Balance of at least 10,000,000 KRW for two semesters.
  - -Issued within 30 days prior to D-4 visa application (most recent one required)
  - -If under parent's name: original proof of family relationship required

### 3) For D-4 Visa Applicants (from Non-Visa Waiver Countries)

### 3. Registration procedure

Online Application and notification via email

- ⇒ Submission of required documents
- -D-4 applicants: email(JPG/PDF) and post(original documents) submission
- -Non D-4 applicants: email(JPG/PDF) submission only
- $\Rightarrow$  Document screening  $\rightarrow$  Results sent by email
- ⇒ Tuition payment
- ⇒ (D-4 applicants only: Issuance of Certificate of Admission for visa application
- ⇒ Visa application and acquisition)
- ⇒ Placement test before the start of the semester(written & speaking)
- $\Rightarrow$  Admission
- \* After completing the online application, you must also notify the ELC via email(kfl2@ewha.ac.kr).
- \* Additional documents may be requested if necessary.
- \* Documents written in languages other than English, Chinese, or Japanese must be submitted with a notarized Korean or English translation.
- \* Students in the Intensive Program will be automatically enrolled in insurance (included in the tuition fee).

# 4. Intensive Korean Language Program Academic

### - Credit Transfer

Up to 6 credits may be transferred toward graduation for students in their first semester at Ewha Womans University, if they are admitted to a Bachelor's program within one year of completing Levels 4-6 of ELC's Intensive Korean Language Program.

(ELC will individually notify eligible students.)

## 5. ELC Scholarships

	ELC Sibling Scholarship	For students with siblings simultaneously enrolled in ELC Korean courses (with proof of family relationship)
	ELC Scholarship of Excellence in Korean Language	Partial tuition support for 2 international freshmen of Ewha Womans University (excluding transfer students) who have completed at least 3 semesters and Level 6 of the Intensive Korean Program at ELC
	Scholarship for Outstanding Korean Learners	50% tuition reduction for Intensive Program students with the highest grades who re-register for the next semester (granted only once)

\* Students can only receive one scholarship per semester.

## Dormitory application

### 1. Application period

- •Intensive Korean Language Program: 2 months before the semester
- •Short-term Korean Language Program: 1~2 months before the semester
- \* Dormitory is assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
- \* Short-term program students can only apply for dorms during the summer vacation (July-August) and winter vacation (February) of Ewha Womans University.
- \* Application results will be notified individually by email within 2 weeks after the deadline.

- Conduct culture classes to help students understand Korean culture and life

#### 1. Target Students

Male and female foreigners or overseas Koreans enrolled in OR have graduated from high school

### 2. Required Documents

- ① Online Application via the website(http://atom.ewha.ac.kr)
- ② Copy of passport
- (3) Copy of Alien Registration Card (front & back; for visa holders only)
- 4 Copy of graduation diploma from the most recent school
- OR copy of certificate of enrollment(if currently attending)
- (5) Photo (JPG only)
  - -File name must match passport name in English(e.g., KIM EWHA)
- If you are from a non-Visa Waiver country, please submit a copy of your visa as well.
- \* ELC does not support visa applications for short-term students.
  Only a receipt for the tuition fee can be issued upon request.
- \* For the safety of students, we recommend enrolling in international student insurance.

- ⇒ Placement test before the start of the semester(written & speaking)
