

## Behavioral Health Academy™ REFERENCE FOR ACADEMIC ADVISORS

- 1. The current structure of the Behavioral Health Academy (BHA) requires:
  - a. students to enroll full-time while taking 651/652.
  - b. students to take their 651/652 practicums consecutively, starting in the fall semester and concluding at the end of the spring semester.
  - c. students to be available during normal business hours (Monday through Friday,9 am-5 pm) for their practicum hours.
  - d. students enroll in the BHA section of the classes. The course map of the final year for BHA students is below.

- 2. BHA Info Sessions for students are offered in January.
- 3. BHA acceptance is typically announced between mid-April and early May.
- 4. Full-time advance standing students are eligible to apply for the BHA upon their acceptance to the pogram. Field Coordinators will condut pre-placement interview, and selected students' resumes will be sent to the BHA in April. Panel Interview will be conducted and acceptance will be announced in late April and early May.
